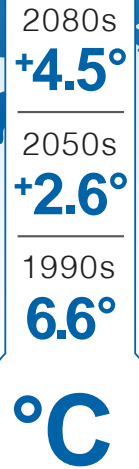


It's Getting Warmer



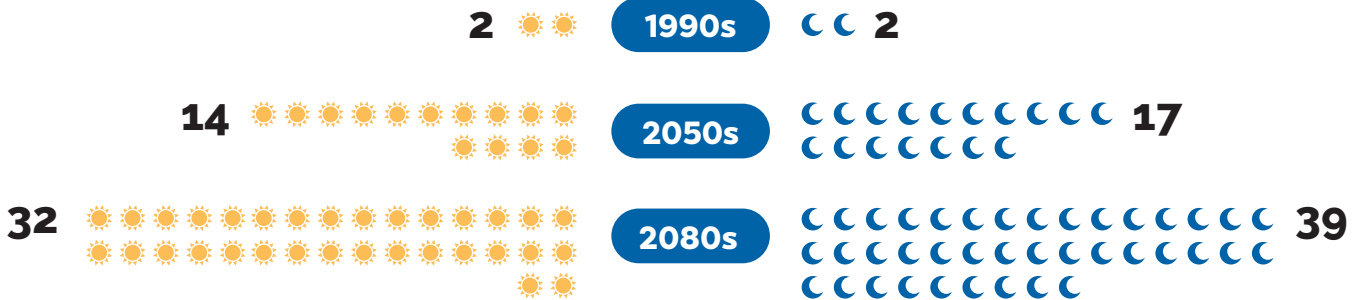
By the end of the century, our average temperature is projected to increase.

+4.5°C

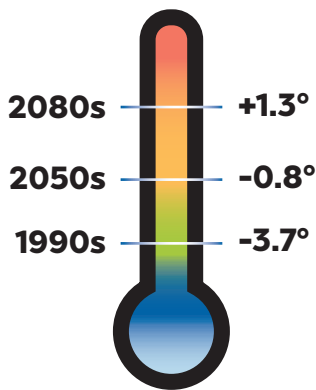
Days and nights will be more uncomfortable.

Days warmer than 29°C.

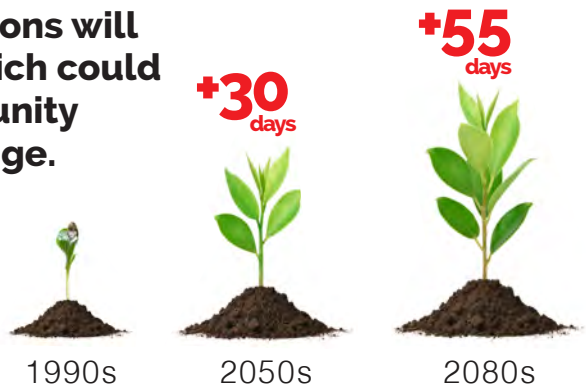
Nights warmer than 18°C.



Our average winter temperature will be above 0°C.



Growing seasons will be longer, which could be an opportunity and a challenge.



Potential Impacts



Higher temperatures will increase electricity demand to cool buildings.



Increased food production capacity, but also the increase of new pests and diseases.



Increased wildfires.



Drought conditions and water shortages.

Climate change scenarios based on RCP 8.5 (median), which most closely matches global emissions to date. Global results downscaled to our local area. Timeframes based on 30-year periods (1981-2010, 2035 - 2065, 2065-2095)
